

Write a thank you letter to John Warren

- Materials:
 - Paper
 - Pencil/pen
 - Colored pencils/crayons/markers
- Pretend that you are Katie and you are writing a thank you letter to John Warren for saving your life. What would you say?
 - Background info: This act demonstrates kindness transcending political alliances as John Warren not only did something good, but he did so despite the fact that Katie's family are "Tories," and he is a "patriot."

Create a mind map

- Materials:
 - Paper
 - Pen/pencil
- Make a mind map of all of the emotions you would have felt if you were in Katie's position of almost being discovered in the trunk
 - Ex: Put "almost discovered" as the big circle and then have different emotions stem from that and they can build off of those until they've created a mind map (use words or drawings or pics cut from magazines)

Make a pros/cons list

- Materials:
 - Paper
 - Pen/pencil
- Fold the paper in half (hamburger style), and then in half again (hamburger style)
- In the top left corner, write "Loyalist Pros;" in the top right corner, write "Loyalist Cons;" in the bottom left near the fold, write "Patriot Pros;" in the bottom right near the fold, write "Patriot Cons"
- Using their prior knowledge and what they learned from the book, write down the pros and cons to being a Loyalist on the top half, and the pros and cons to being being a patriot on the bottom half
- THEN do the same again but as if the war was happening today and you had to choose, how would you feel about breaking away from America and becoming a new country? Did your point of view change?
